

ANGELS – 06 – A

1A – Hebrews 1:14-14. Angels are ministering spirits sent forth by the Lord to minister to every person who trusts in the Lord and serves Him.

2A – Genesis 3:4. Angels could not be the spirits of the departed dead, because they were in existence BEFORE the first man died. Adam was made a little lower than the angels, Ps. 8th4, 5.

3A – Ezekiel 28:14-15. Lucifer (Isaiah 14:12), as one of the highest angels, was CREATED. It follows that if Lucifer was created, all the rest of the angels were also created. They were created by the Son of God BEFORE He made Adam and this world, Col. 1:15-17.

4A – Ezekiel 10:12. (See center margin reading for “body) Angels are not immaterial phantoms without form or parts, but they are real beings with spiritual bodies of a spiritual flesh, 1 Cor. 15:44. Angels appeared to Abraham and Lot as real beings, Gen 18:1-8; 19:1-3. They eat, Ps. 78:24-25; and talk, Acts 1:9-11. At the last day when Jesus comes, our natural bodies are changed to glorious spiritual bodies, Phil. 3:20-21; 1 Cor. 15:44; then we will be equal to the angels, Luke 20:35-36.

5A – Revelation 5:11. There are many more angels in God’s universe than there are people in this world, Hebrews 12:22.

6A – Matthew 18:10. In speaking of the Father’s watch care over His children, Jesus mentions “their angels”, showing that to every child of God an angel is assigned. Among those countless billions of angels, there is one assigned to watch over you day and night.

7A – Psalms 91:11-12. This angel has been given charge over you to help you in your journey to heaven.

8A – Psalms 34:7. There is a promise of help when we obey.

9A – Matthew 25:31. All the holy angels will come to earth when Jesus comes in His glory. Angels will also help you to be ready for that day.
